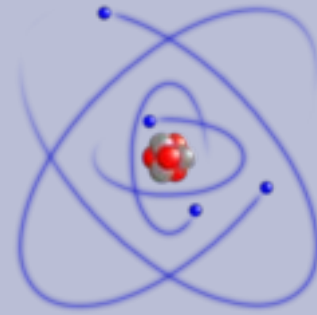

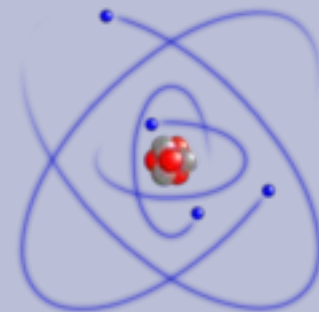

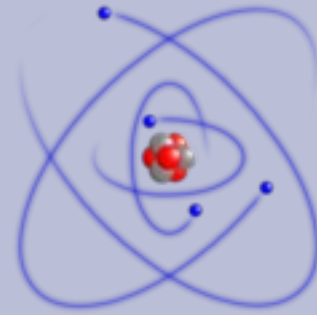

Scientific Linux Plenary Discussion



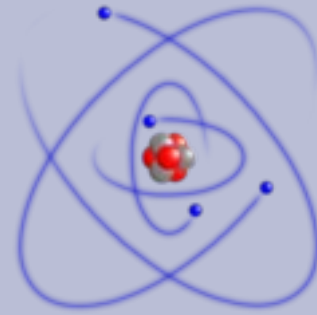
- Support time line for Scientific Linux 4
 - Spring 2008 Hepix we decided that SL 4 would be supported until 2010 October 10
 - Do the labs still feel this is a good date?
 - Red Hat changed their support structure
 - Here is Red Hat's support policy

 - Production 1 (Full Support) 4 Years
 - Production 2 (Transition) Year 5
 - Production 3 (Maintenance) Years 6-7
 - RHEL 4 was released Feb 2005

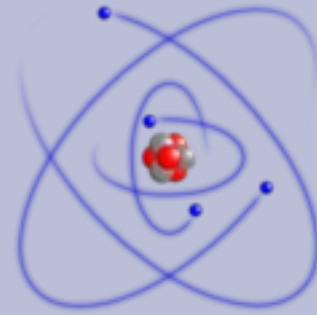
- New Hardware
